

⚠ IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using ladders, basic precautions should always be followed, which include the following:

1. Read all the instructions and keep for reference.
2. Inspect all parts prior to use ensuring all the screws are fixed securely.
3. Floors should be clean, not slippery.
4. Do not overreach, move the ladder to a more suitable position.
5. Do not exceed the maximum weight load limit: 330 pounds.
6. Never work sideways.
7. Wear flat firm soled shoes. Never work in high heels, bare feet or slippers.
8. Check that there are no overhead hazards near where you are going to work.
9. Never have more than one person on the stepladder at any one time.
10. Always have both your feet on a step.
11. Always take care when mounting and dismounting. Always mount and dismount facing towards the ladder.
12. Close supervision is necessary when used by or near children.
13. Do not put loose tools where they could move or fall and cause an injury.
14. If you do find any structural damage do not attempt to repair it yourself.
15. Do not use the Genius® Safety Ladder for anything other than its intended use.
16. This Genius® Safety Ladder is for HOUSEHOLD USE only.

The Genius® Safety Ladder has front and side safety rails for reassuring extra support, stability, safety and confidence. With so many practical uses around the home, from decorating inside to cleaning windows outside, even pruning in the garden, it's so helpful. The two side rails are complimented by oversized W38xD26cm non-slip rubber trim steps and an extra- high front safety rail which reaches 61cm above the top step for holding or leaning against. The 4 step ladder has a maximum standing height of 95cm from the floor.

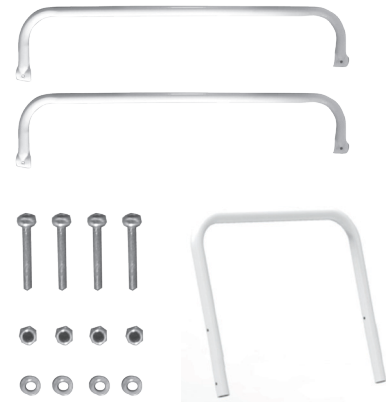

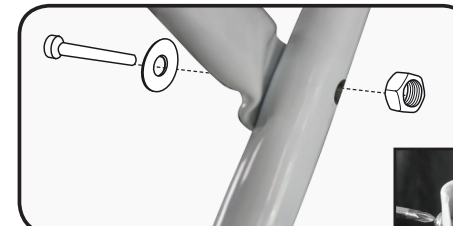


Note: Protective Rubber Caps are attached to protect product during transit. Please remove these before assembly.

ASSEMBLING THE PRODUCT

- Slide on top hand rail until it clips into place. (Fig. 1)
- There are 2 holes at the top and bottom of the side hand rails.
- Place the hand rail over the outside of the ladder main frame and top hand rail, ensuring all the holes are aligned. (Fig. 2)
- Insert the bolt through the hole in the hand rail and tighten with a screw driver through the ladder main frame.
- Then add washer and then the lock nut, then tighten (see diagram below).
- To secure both hand rails, repeat the same action for all 4 holes
- Now the ladder is assembled.

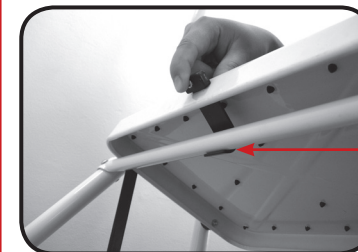


Ensure the hand rail is secured well by using a screwdriver and 1cm spanner to tighten the bolt and nut.

BEFORE USE

- Ensure all the bolts and lock nuts are tight.
- Check the hand rail is securely fixed to the main frame, and if slightly loose retighten all bolts and nuts before use.
- Any missing non-slip feet must be replaced before use.
- Make sure that the steps are all clean and dry.
- The ground should be firm, flat and level.
- Remember to take it slow and steady when going up and down the ladder using hand rail.

VERY IMPORTANT



BEFORE USE:
The safety locking clip underneath the top step must be secured into position

To fold down, push down on the black lever to release the safety locking clip, before folding

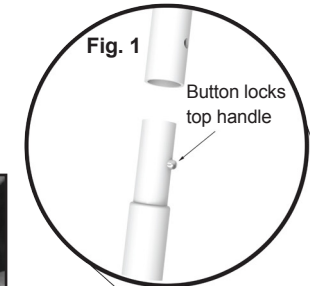
